### Meeting Minutes

1. President's Report – Sara Wilbur
  - a. Boon Supply Fundraiser ended - \$1,432 in sales resulting in \$574 in profit
  - b. Apparel Sale run by Heather Alves with Shelton Printing (~15 items out of 115 not available due to supply shortages – will refund purchasers)
  - c. PTO supplied soap, cups, hand sanitizer, masks to BHS
2. Treasurer's Report – Gina Colgan
  - a. Total amount in all accounts: \$13,646.22
  - b. Income since last meeting: Fall Social Trunk or Treat (\$1,830.33), Membership dues now totaling \$1,525, Restaurant Night (\$320), Amazon Smile now totaling \$100.02, Birthday Signs now totaling \$14 since had to purchase more signs which cost \$276.
  - c. Expenses since last meeting: Reading/Math party (\$146.83), Bank Charges (\$60.81), Misc (\$163.15 for Book Fair bags, BJ's and masks), Classroom Funds – Halloween Party (\$251.34), Teacher Treat (\$65.59), Square Fees now totaling \$361.12.
